Using the PTI Symbol(s) General Guidelines

The PTI Symbol(s) have been created by the Power Tool Institute for manufacturers of electric and cordless power tools to demonstrate compliance with a series of voluntary guidelines. The voluntary guideline(s) created by PTI are consensus documents developed by the major U. S. manufacturers of power tools to standardize the manner in which various performance characteristics are measured and communicated to the consumer.

These symbol(s) may appear on a power tool, its packaging, the operator's manual and general advertising following completion of the License Agreement. Use of the symbol(s) indicates that the manufacturer of the power tool has measured a particular performance characteristic using the PTI voluntary guideline(s), and the corresponding published performance characteristic value(s) accurately reflect such measurement.

The Power Tool Institute makes no representation that it has determined compliance with the guideline(s), nor does the Power Tool Institute approve of their performance characteristics in any manner.

Companies using the PTI Symbol(s) must follow these general guidelines:

- 1. The PTI Symbol must never be used in a manner which implies PTI endorsement of a company, its products or its services.
- 2. The PTI Symbol must never be used to imply membership in the Power Tool Institute.
- 3. The symbol must be used as presented in black and white and may not be altered.
- 4. The PTI Symbol may be used only on the power tool, its packaging, the operator's manual, and/or in general advertising.
- 5. The symbol must never be used in any way that would disparage PTI or its individual members.
- 6. The symbol must never be used except to indicate compliance with a PTI voluntary guideline.
